### **Luke 22: 19-20**

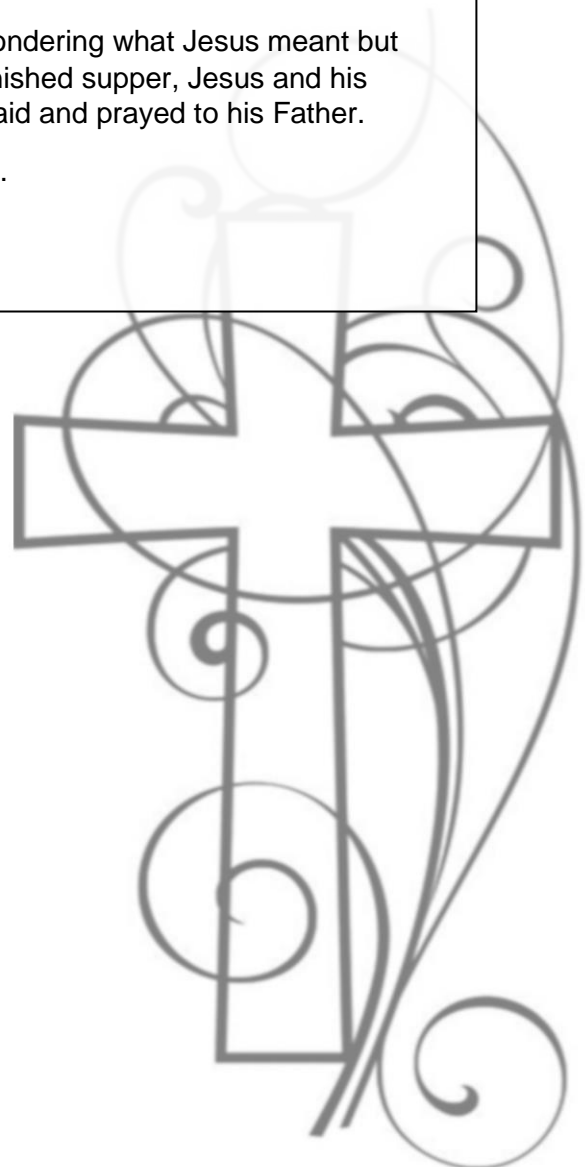

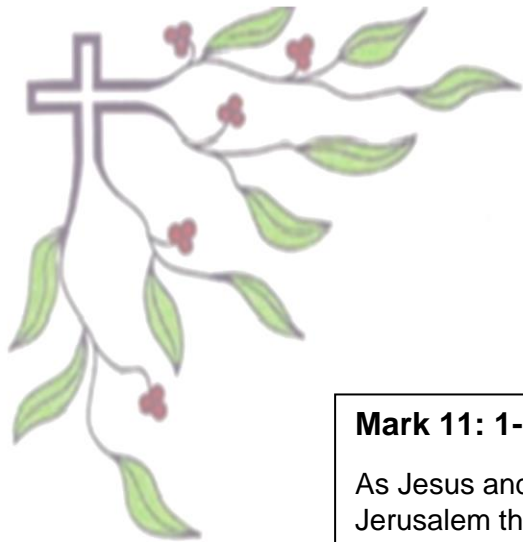
Jesus' friends took the bread and ate it, thinking about Jesus and knowing how much he loved them.
