### January Optimism

The month of January is named after Janus, the Roman god of beginnings, endings, transitions, and doorways. Janus is often depicted with two faces, one looking forward and one looking backward, to represent his ability to see both the past and future. As we progress through January, we can leave behind past mistakes and negative experiences and create a path towards personal growth and fulfilment. The life of a Catholic makes no sense unless it is a life of constant spiritual growth. To cease to grow in our spiritual lives is to become indifferent to God. Here are four things you might do in January to help you grow.

1. Truly participate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Many people attend Mass in a distracted frame of mind. Yet in the Mass we encounter Christ in a unique and unparalleled way. Be fully present and prepared. Do not rush into Church thinking of a thousand things.
2. Take advantage of confession. Sinfulness is part of the human condition, one that separates us from Christ. Christ offers us a way to put our sins behind us and to experience once again His loving embrace through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
3. Develop a life of prayer. Every moment is an opportunity for prayer. How often do you take advantage of these opportunities?
4. Encounter Christ in the Scriptures. Reading the Scriptures meditatively can be of enormous help in coming to know Christ.

These things are possible and achievable for us all. Take up the challenge! It can help you feel optimistic about the future. Optimism can energize you and uplift you, and it can help you keep a positive outlook.
