Following the announcement in December of the miraculous cure of John (Jack) Traynor, the Archdiocese of Liverpool will be celebrating this historic moment with Mass followed by a drink's reception at the **Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King on Tuesday 18th February at 7pm.**

## Lourdes 2025 Parish Pilgrimage

Thank you to everyone who have already shown interest to our parish pilgrimage to Lourdes - Thursday 24th July until Thursday 31st July 2025. We have received a good number of positive responses. This is immensely helpful for our forward planning.

We will be staying in the Hotel Roissy, and the cost is **£1045** with a single room supplement to be added. There's still time to come on pilgrimage, but you will need to contact the Parish Office now with some urgency. If you intend to join our Lourdes 2025 pilgrimage, please come to the planning meeting at **7.00pm** on **Thursday 13th February** in **St. Bede's Church**. All are welcome.

This 2025 pilgrimage to Lourdes has special significance for the Archdiocese of Liverpool as the Church has declared the case of John (Jack) Traynor a miracle. Jack was a pilgrim on the Archdiocese's first official pilgrimage to Lourdes in 1923 and was cured dramatically of epilepsy, paralysis of the right arm and paraplegia during the pilgrimage. It is the first English miracle to be recognised at Lourdes.
