### What are you giving up for...?

I am often bereft when Lent comes to an end. I love Easter, it's great. But Lent is probably my favourite liturgical season. During Lent we live our Christian faith in a fuller sense. The season encourages us to be more prayerful, to live a simpler lifestyle and to be kinder. Lent is a 'spa for the soul', ridding us of spiritual toxicity and rejuvenating us for our mission as disciples of Jesus. In Lent, we become the best versions of ourselves.

This is all in full swing and then Easter Day comes along. All the things we took on, well, we give them up for Easter. Normal programming resumes, which usually involves less prayer, less simplicity, less charity. It happens every year. As a child, I had a very glum view of Lent. 'Giving up' your favourite things doesn't ring well with most folks, but especially unwell with children. But now I see Lent in terms of 'gain and grace'.

In reality, the aim of Lent is not to 'give things up for a few weeks' but always to receive more from our generous God. A treasure chest of grace is opened to us on Ash Wednesday and it's down to us to grab what we can and run. Let us grab the precious jewels of prayer, of simplicity and of love and take them forward through Lent, to Easter and beyond into everlasting life.

May we support each other in this great venture. From now on, maybe we should ask each other; "what are you gaining for eternity?"

## Parish Pilgrimage to Lourdes 2025

Thank you to all who attended the initial meeting to express interest in our parish pilgrimage to Lourdes this year. We have now received further information from the tour operator and can progress the group booking arrangements. The revised dates for the pilgrimage are confirmed as **Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> July to Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> July 2025**. We will travel as **one group** on these dates.

We have block booked rooms for the parish in the **Hotel Roissy**, located 100 metres from the entrance of Lourdes Sanctuary. This 4-star hotel offers soundproofed and air-conditioned rooms with free Wi-Fi and a flat-screen satellite TV. The cost (without single room supplement but including the extra night due to the changed dates), is £1,075.00. We require a **deposit of £350.00** by cash or cheque made payable to 'Northern Star Travel Ltd' to secure your place.

To progress our group booking we ask that all pilgrims attend a short meeting in St Bede's presbytery at **7pm on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> March** to fill out a 'completion of booking' form and to pay the deposit. There may be an opportunity for anyone who hasn't expressed an interest so far to join us. Please come along if you are interested.
